# UNOPPOSED MOTION TO EXTEND DEADLINE TO SUBMIT STIPULATION OF DISMISSAL

Defendant Bank of America, N.A. moves to extend the deadline for the parties to submit dismissal documents as to Bank of America. The following grounds support this Motion:

- 1. On December 5, 2019, this Court entered an Order resetting the Scheduling Conference until February 10, 2020, to allow the Plaintiff and the Defendants to finalize their settlement and dismiss the case by February 3, 2020.
- 2. As stated in the stipulated notice of settlement filed December 4, 2019, Plaintiff and the Defendants have reached a settlement agreement in principal. (ECF No. 27.)
- 3. Plaintiff and Bank of America have been negotiating the terms of the settlement agreement in good faith and have been exchanging draft agreements memorializing the terms of

the settlement. Once the settlement agreement is finalized, it will need to be submitted to and

approved by the Receivership Court. Plaintiff and Bank of America anticipate this will be

accomplished on or before March 5, 2020.

4. Bank of America requests that the Scheduling Conference be vacated to allow

additional time to finalize the terms of the settlement and to have the settlement agreement

approved by the Receivership Court.

5. To provide adequate time to complete these tasks, Bank of America requests an

additional 31 days, up to and including Monday, March 5, 2020, to submit the stipulation of

dismissal between Plaintiff and Bank of America.

6. Counsel for Plaintiff has reviewed the form and content of this Motion and the

proposed order and approves of same.

WHEREFORE, Defendant Bank of America requests that the Court consider this Motion,

vacate the scheduling conference set for February 10, 2020, and extend the deadline to enter the

dismissal with the Court to, through and including March 5, 2020, and for such other and further

relief that the Court deems appropriate.
